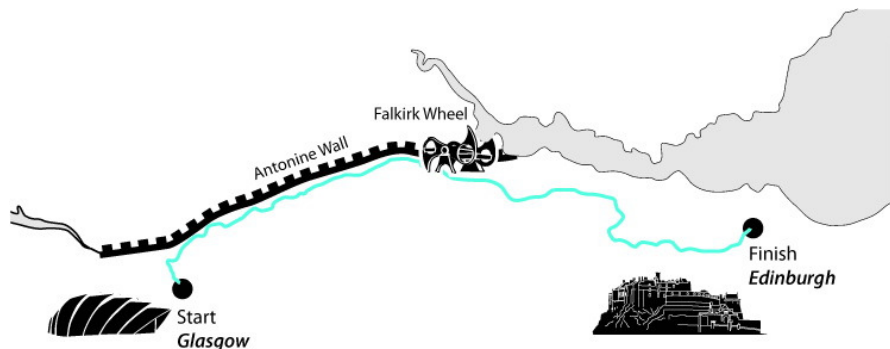




The Glasgow-Edinburgh Double Marathon 2010 follows the towpaths of the Forth & Clyde and Union canals and takes in sights both old and new: the route follows large sections of the Antonine Wall as well as taking in the Falkirk Wheel before entering Scotland's historic capital. The 56 mile course is predominantly flat, though the route and changeable Scottish weather is sure to provide a challenge for both the novice and seasoned ultrarunner alike.

The race starts at 9am on Saturday 6th March in Ruchill Park, Glasgow. The race will take place under UK Athletics Regulations. All athletes must be aged 20 or older on the day of the race.
